

Host GRI Introductory Workshop

As an organisation you now have the unique opportunity to host a GRI Introductory Workshop specifically tailored to your organisation's needs and those of your stakeholders.

What is the purpose of the workshop?

The half day Workshop will provide participants with a basic introduction to GRI and the G3.1 framework. It will explore current trends in reporting and demonstrate the role of GRI in assisting organisations to manage and report on their social, economic and environmental impacts.

What are the learning outcomes?

Upon completion of the workshop participants will be able to:

- Recognise the trends in and drivers for sustainability in organisations
- Differentiate between philanthropy and responsible (sustainable) management
- Provide reasons why organisations of all types and sizes are preparing sustainability reports
- Explain what GRI is and how it can help their organisations to understand and measure sustainability impacts, risks and opportunities
- Identify the main characteristics of the GRI framework for reporting
- Identify and guide through the five phases of the sustainability reporting process
- Prepare a realistic timeline for covering the major activities necessary to complete a GRI report
- Discuss and define topics and indicators that reflect their organisations significant economic, environmental and social impacts

Who is the workshop for?

This workshop is for novice reporters who want to understand GRI and the GRI reporting process; it will provide participants with a general introduction to GRI and the G3.1 reporting framework.
